With May now behind us, we've passed one of several key legislative deadlines this year, the House of Origin deadline. My team in Sacramento has been working tirelessly to ensure we continue to foster innovation and growth for our state. My district team continues their outreach in the community to hear directly from you and our office's 5th biannual upcoming Health and Resources Fair on June 22nd at Loara High School, in partnership with Anaheim Councilmember Carlos Leon. LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

This month, we continued to see a number of our bills pass out of the Senate before the House of Origin deadline. This deadline requires all bills to make it out of the house in which they're introduced, and can often see several high-profile bills fail. One of our bills that made it through, SB 910, focused on treatment courts. This bill would apply a best practices standard to California's collaborative and treatment courts, ensuring quality care for Californians who opt-in to these programs. Together, we can and should work to keep people out of our jails and prisons.
